



Per Angelstam (male) works as professor (forest and natural resource management) at the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences, and as an entrepreneur focusing on rural and regional sustainable development in Sweden and internationally. He focuses on sustainability science by knowledge production about both social and ecological systems in landscapes and regions representing different contexts, as well as collaboration with practitioners to encourage evidence-based learning at different levels of governance, planning and management. Per is a member of LTER-Europe Executive Committee's expert panel for Long-Term Social-Ecological Research (LTSER) platforms, and leader of the HORIZON 2020 eLTER project's work (2015-19) on this topic. He is chairman of the board of the NGO Sustainable Bergslagen in Sweden (member of www.imfn.net and the LTSER network). He has written 179 articles for international peer-review journals, 35 peer-review book chapters, 83 conference articles, 65 reports, and 79 popular science publications. Per's Google Scholar lists 12939 citations and the h-index is 57, Research gate lists 9628 citations with an index of 40.1, and Scopus lists 6000 citations with an h-index of 40 (October 2018).
